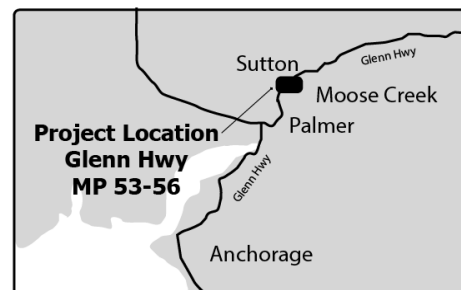

SURVEY CREWS ON SITE

Over the next month, you may see some DOT&PF survey crews in the project area near Buffalo Mine Road. Please use caution when workers are near the roadway.

DOT&PF has moved the project start location (currently MP53) to the west approximately 1/2 mile to Soapstone Road. The reason for this change is to accommodate the relocation of the existing WIM (Weigh in Motion) vehicle scale and traffic count sensor. The survey crews will be gathering information necessary for project engineers to conduct design work for this newly added portion of the roadway.
