## Watch for Construction Projects This Summer

While construction of the Glenn Highway MP 53-56 Reconstruction at Moose Creek Canyon is not anticipated to begin until 2018, there are other Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) projects active near the Moose Creek project area.

The two DOT&PF projects currently under construction:

- Glenn Highway MP 42-56 Pavement Preservation (Project No. 56663)
- Glenn Highway MP 56-61 Pavement Preservation (Project No. 56683)

In addition to resurfacing the roadway, these projects will replace guardrail, and provide signing and new striping.

There will be some impacts to drivers associated with these projects, please expect minor delays, as well as lane restrictions, flagging, and pilot car operations from 8AM-8PM Mon-Fri. Also, please use caution in construction areas, as there will be intermittent gravel surfaces in the area.

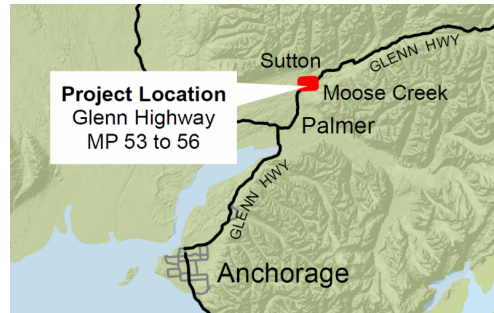

### Why Repave MP 53-56 Now?

It is notable that the Glenn Highway MP 42-56 Pavement Preservation will resurface the same portion of Glenn impacted by the Glenn Hwy MP 53-56 Reconstruction Project.

Why would we resurface this portion of the roadway now? This current pavement preservation project will extend the design life of the Glenn Highway in the area. While a portion of the Glenn Highway will be removed during construction of the MP 53-56 Reconstruction Project, much of the existing roadway will still be in use after the new bridge and roadway are built.



## Project Update

The Glenn Highway MP 53-56 Reconstruction project team continues work on refinements to the project design, and tasks such as an eagle nest survey (already complete) for the environmental process. DOT&PF anticipates entering into the next phase of the project, right-of-way acquisition, later this year. We anticipate the right-of-way acquisition process to take two to three years to complete.
