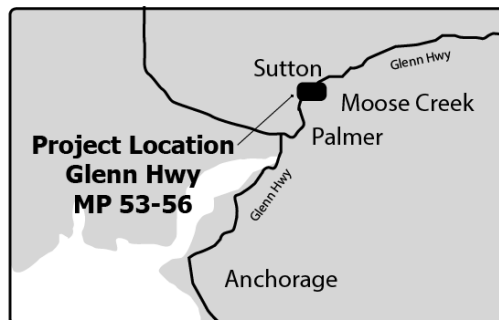

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), proposes to reconstruct the Glenn Highway between Milepost (MP) 53 and 56, a section of road that currently has an undesirable steep grade and tight curves with limited sight distances. The proposed realignment of this three-mile section of the Glenn Highway will require a new bridge over Moose Creek, approximately 2,800 feet downstream from the existing bridge. Design work and property acquisition is anticipated to last through 2018, followed by construction.



You are invited to attend a **Public Open House on Tuesday, September 9, 2014 from 4-7 PM at the Sutton Library** to learn about the project's design, scope, and schedule and to provide your feedback. At the Open House project team members will be present to answer questions, provide project details, and solicit comments.
