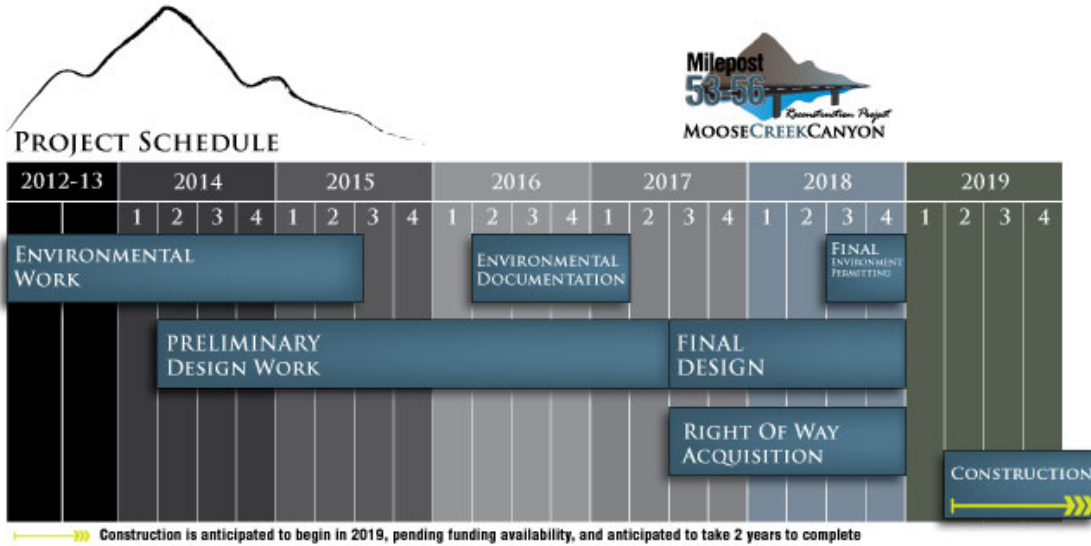
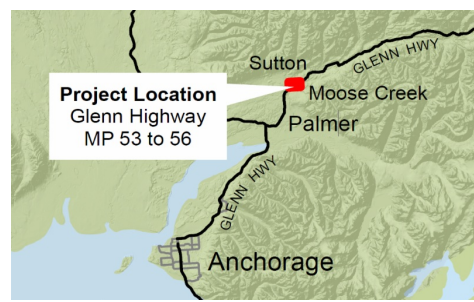

Project Update

DOT&PF has finished a survey of historic and cultural resources in the project area, an activity that is one of the requirements in the project's environmental process. We are currently coordinating with the State's Office of History and Archaeology/State Historic Preservation Office regarding the findings of this survey, and will consult with several parties that have resources affected by the project. This process is taking longer than originally planned, and as a result the project schedule has been revised.

We now anticipate entering into the next phase of the project, right of way (ROW)

appraisal and acquisition, in 2017. In addition to acquiring ROW, over the next two years the project's environmental and permitting work will continue, and the engineering team will finalize the project design. Following final design, the DOT&PF will bid and select a construction contractor to build the project. Given the updated [project schedule](#), construction is now slated to begin in 2019, pending the availability of funding and other factors.
