Glenn Highway MP 53-56 Reconstruction, Moose Creek Canyon

Summer Construction Projects

While construction of the Glenn Highway Milepost (MP) 53-56 Reconstruction at Moose Creek Canyon is planned to begin in 2018, there are other Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) projects active near the Moose Creek project area.

Area roadway projects currently, or soon-to-be, under construction:

Glenn Highway MP 42-61 Pavement Preservation - Much of this project has been constructed and most work is complete. Crews will be on site this summer replacing guardrails, replacing signage, and completing other final project tasks.

Glenn Highway MP 49, Palmer Fishhook to Archie Road - Starting in late May, expect lane closures and new traffic patterns that will be in place for the remainder of the season. [Click here for more information.](#)

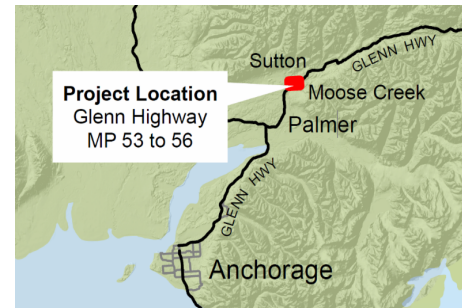
Glenn Highway MP 63 & 64 Erosion Project - Slated to start late this summer, this

project will extend the existing riprap (rock used to armor shorelines) at MP 63.3 and 64.3 to address areas adjacent to the roadway that have been eroded by the Matanuska River. This project is anticipated to be completed within approximately one year.

Chickaloon River Bridge - This bridge replacement project at the Chickaloon River, located at MP 78 of the highway, began last summer and is continuing through this construction season. Expect intermittent delays and some single lane closures. [Click here for more information.](#)

There will be impacts to drivers associated with these projects; please expect some delays. Always drive with caution in construction areas as there can be workers near the roadway, intermittent gravel surfaces, and other conditions that require your attention.

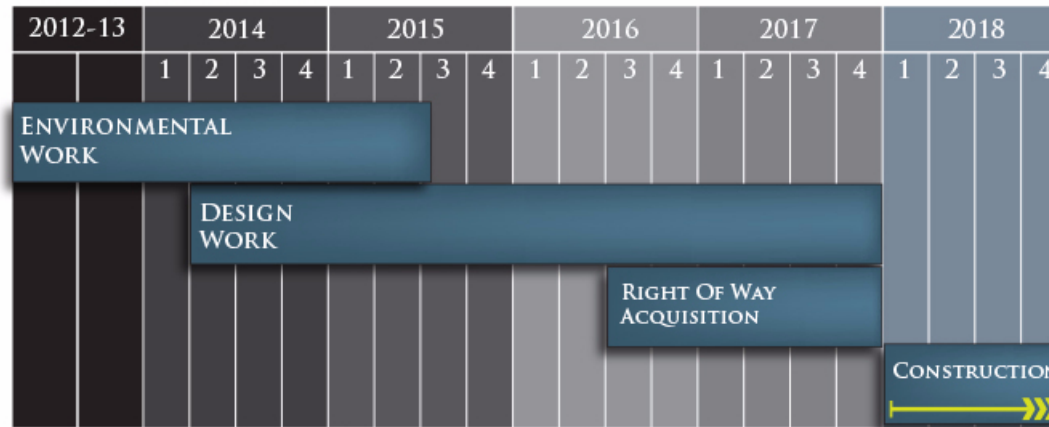


Project Update

DOT&PF anticipates entering into the next phase of the project, right of way (ROW) acquisition, later this year. The project team also plans to hold another public meeting this fall.

During the next two years, the ROW appraisal and acquisition process will progress, and the engineering team will finalize the project design to 95% complete. Following final design, DOT&PF will select a construction contractor to build the project.

Construction is slated to begin in 2018, pending the availability of funding and other factors.



Construction is anticipated to take 2 years to complete, pending funding availability.
